### TERM 1

Week 1: Allah –Allah is One – (BK1 CH1)

- Activity – pictures of different fruits and animals and match them to their origin and then back to Allah to show Allah gives life.

Week 4: Allah – Allah is all hearing – (BK1 CH4)

- Allah hears everything whether quiet or loud.
- Allah hears everyone.
- Allah hears our prayers wherever we are.

- Praying to Allah for things we want and need.
- Ask Allah for help
- Activity – To write down a list of things that they wish for or need help with and discuss with everyone.

#### Week 5: Using the toilet – (BK1 CH24& BK2 CH8)

- Explain Istinja
- Dua before entering the toilet.
- Entering with the left foot
- Being in total Privacy, closing the door.
- Keeping clothes clean.
- Sitting and urinating
- No talking in the toilet.
- Not to mention Allah's name nor take anything that has Allah's name on/in it inside the bathroom.
- Make a list of Dos and Don'ts on the board with pictures.

#### Week 6: Using the toilet (BK1 CH24& BK2 CH8)

- Using water to clean oneself (istinja)
- Using tissue
- Using left hand
- Washing hands with soap after using the toilet
- Right foot when leaving
- Full leaving the toilet dua.

#### Week 7:Etiquettes of eating and drinking – (BK1 CH25)
